
Unusual Tracks Part Three

Went into the area where the first set of tracks were found and found some of the same tracks on almost exactly the same path as the previous ones. The ground was much drier so the tracks were less clear. Tracks were the same size as the previous, 6 inches wide by 4 inches long. There was also a smattering of ill defined possibly smaller tracks 4 by 4 inches (?). I documented two of the better larger

ones and did manage to get a step length of 48 inches. All of this evidence is being consistent over time.



While I was doing the documentation I heard, faintly, what sounded like a large dog whining, it was a bit breezy and the sounds could just as easily have been tree limbs rubbing together rather than anything else.



One other item of note; I enter this area through a choke point in a band of multi-flora rose which commonly grows on the fringes of forest in this area. This is a great place to monitor movements of animals moving from one area

of forest to another. I will often find 14 to 17 inch Sasquatch foot impressions on this path. Since Januarys' canid tracks I have not found any sign of big hairy people in the area. On this day I found very fresh foot impressions of the correct length and soil compression moving into the area. In all of my research areas if I



find coyote tracks I won't find Sasquatch tracks and vice versa. I have no idea why this would be but there seems to be a correlation with the larger canid tracks.
